- 5 Implementation of the e-FLIP Model in secondary education VET Good practices/examples – all high schools (tools and lesson plans = QR codes if possible and hyperlinks for sure, screenshots of the tools' usage) + references

Specifications of e-Book:

- structuring the e- Book with necessary chapters,
- deciding on the focus of each chapter which should address at least the following features: introduction of e-FLIP teaching model with theoretical background, four components of the model, digital tools appropriate to each component, principles and description of exemplary practices, - TR
- deciding on the writing style and lengths of each chapter, (3000 6000 words?)
- - dividing writing duties among the partners,
  - o Introduction
  - Explanation, etc.
  - <u>All tools will be described in 1 chapter (by a structured table/overview)</u>
- - designing and typesetting of the e-Book, SK (collab with ES and TR)
- - editing the e-Book, SK
- obtaining an ISBN and publishing the e-Book, TR
- sharing and advertising the e-Book to reach a wider audience (on the webpage, MEs) all partners
- Final e-Book will be produced in InDesign SK

All partners will work together to make a decision on the number of chapters, focus of chapters, lengths and writing style.

- GAUN will write about the extended e-FLIP Teaching Model with a theoretical background. - TR

- <u>City of Reykjavík, Europass Berlin and INNOVED</u> will write chapters about digital tools for learning activities, teaching materials and assessment instruments.

- <u>Pro scholaris, I.I.S. GRANDIS, Institut Guillem Catà & City of Reykjavík</u> will describe sample teaching/learning activities, teaching materials and assessment instruments. (including (all) the materials) = teachers' reflections (to the model, teaching, inclusion – students with special needs and their improvement in terms of e-FLIP use)

- Pro scholaris will provide samples of detailed lesson plans for the e-FLIP Model.

- Institut Guillem Catà and I.I.S. GRANDIS will provide samples detailed inclusive lesson plans for e-FLIP Model.

- Pro scholaris will carry out designing and typesetting of the e-Book.

Volos trainings: The main goals of LTT4 are;

- to instruct teachers/ participants in principles of finalized e- FLIP Teaching Model,

- to examine digital platform enriched with the e-FLIP teacher training module to make it ready for the pilot study.

- to finalize the e- FLIP teacher training Module to be presented in the digital platform with sample lesson plans, digital contents, learning and evaluation activities

- to plan testing e-FLIP Teacher Training Module and digital platform in pilot schools and partner schools - including inclusive settings. (This piloting includes, teacher training on e-FLIP Model, Web 2 tools, developing teaching materials, teaching learning activities, measurement instruments via e- FLIP Teacher Training Module to be embedded in Digital platform)

### Results of the Activity:

At the end of the training, teachers and participants are expected to know the WEB 2 tools that can be used to design digital instructional activities. They are also expected to be competent enough to use e-FLIP teaching Module and the platform to give teacher training on this module. Participants will have an action plan on how to implement and test e- FLIP Teacher Training Module and Digital Platform in their schools and pilot schools.
