Multiplier Events in Iceland

After the finalization of the Project results of the e-FLIP project, two multiplier events were organized in Reykjavík. The first Multiplier Event was on the 10th of October 2023 and the second one on the 23rd of October 2023. Both events were held at the Town Hall conference room in the City of Reykjavík. In the first event all department heads from the primary schools (age 6 -16 y) in Reykjavík were invited to participate. 14 attended and 5 were online.

In the second event teachers, teacher candidates, academicians from the University of Iceland, and department heads of the Office of Education and Youth in Reykjavik were invited. Teachers and department heads from the municipalities around Reykjavik were also invited. 44 people attended the event.

These events were the official launch of the Project results of the project. The participants were invited by the Center of Language and literacy due to time differences with Turkey. The aim of these multiplier events was:

- to disseminate the PRs Flipped Online Teaching Model and Module and e--Book,
- to share the results and end-products of the project with educators and policy makers,
- to raise an awareness about tools and approaches for an effective and inclusive e-teaching that will serve teachers' and teacher candidates' Digital Education Readiness,
- to share exemplary practices of the developed e-Flipped approach,
- to share the insights gained during transnational project meetings in partner countries.

The target group of these multiplier events were teachers (as general), teacher candidates, academicians, experts, and policy/decision makers.

The outcomes of the multiplier events will be published online via project website and thus, the final beneficiaries of this event's number will be increased. The results and outcomes of the event will be disseminated via project web site, project social media pages, media/ press bulletin and news and project partners' official web sites.

In the events the e-FLIP model, the e-FLIP homepage and the e-FLIP training module and the e. Book were introduced and discussed. All materials were then sent to the attendants, and they will introduce it in their schools and workplaces.
